We are grateful for your presence and invite you to participate fully in the liturgy. All the responses, prayers and music may be found in this Worship Aid.


If you are a guest or visitor, we thank you for joining us today and hope you will return often.

PEOPLE: Amen.


#### GREETING


Presider: The Lord be with you.

People: Amen





The Alleluia Refrain is repeated after the response.


#### HOMILY







Who live and reign for ever and ever.


PEOPLE: Amen.


