If you would like to become a member of our parish, please stop by the **Welcome and Registration Table** in the O'Gara Gathering Space. A parishioner will be there and happy to help you.


We warmly welcome the presence of children at Mass. If your little one needs extra attention during Mass, please feel free to step into the Gathering Space until they are ready to return to the assembly.

PEOPLE: Amen.


Presider: The peace of the Lord be with you always.

PEOPLE: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.




No gluten reception of Communion, the Blood of Christ, is available for those receiving from the Cup Minister closest to the musicians first. Then all others may drink from that cup.


Low gluten hosts are available upon request from any Bread Minister. Low gluten hosts are consecrated in a separate pyx.
