We warmly welcome the presence of children at Mass. If your little one needs extra attention during Mass, please feel free to step into the Gathering Space until they are ready to return to the assembly.

Seeds, Sunday morning prayer with 3, 4, and 5 year-olds, is offered during the 9 a.m liturgy.

Liturgy of the Word with Children is offered during the 9 a.m. Mass. School-age children, 6 and older, are invited. The children return to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist with the full assembly. Registration is not required.

No gluten reception of Communion, the Blood of Christ, is available for those receiving from the cup minister closest to the musicians first. Then all others may drink from that cup.

Low gluten hosts are available upon request from any bread minister. Low gluten hosts are consecrated in a separate pyx.

Hearing assistance devices are available to use during Mass. They can be found in the vesting room near the font. Ushers can assist you.





Repeat the Alleluia.






4:30 Mass **Apostles' Creed**

PEOPLE: We lift them up to the Lord.







PRESIDER: Behold the Lamb of God,


behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.
